## JNPT bags Rajbhasha Kirti Puskarak

Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust was awarded Rajbhasha Kirti Puskarak, first prize for the year 2014-15 by the Department of Official Language, Ministry of Home Affairs, for excellent implementation of Official Language Hindi. The award was presented by the Hon'ble President of India, Shri Pranab Mukherjee, on the occasion of Hindi Day, 14th September, 2015. JNPT is the first recipient of the prize after its remaining among the category of Boards/ Autonomous bodies of the Central Govt. in "B" region. The Chairman of JNPT Shri Anil Diggikar, IAS, congratulated all the employees for this achievement.

## Highest ever cargo handled by JNPT

Mumbai: Jawaharlal Nehru Port Container Terminal (JNPT), Port owned Container Terminal handled 131,991 TEUs container traffic in August-2015, which is highest ever, cargo handled by JNPT since its inception. Previous record was 131,234 TEUs in April-2006. The growth over previous month is 4.07% and 11.05% over same month last year. In the month of July 15, terminal had handled 1,26,000 TEUs, which again was quite high as compared to corresponding month of July 14 figure of 1,19,000 TEUs. FY2015-16 (Apr to Aug) Traffic handled is 583,648 TEUs, registering a growth of 2.23% over same period last year.

Highest Loading of crude oil in current financial year in vessel MT Abul Kalam Azad of Shipping Corporation of India at BPCL Liquid Cargo Terminal on 21st September.

As M/s ONGC were facing critical High Stock situation, they had requested JNPT for immediate berthing of the vessel MT Abul Kalam Azad on 19th September 2015 and allow loading of maximum permissible quantity of Crude oil to tide over the High stock situation. Accordingly the vessel was given priority (On arrival) berthing and was berthed at 16:45 hrs on 19th September 2015 at its BPCL run Liquid Cargo Terminal. 67,349 MT of Crude oil was loaded on the vessel with a sailing draft of 13.1 meters. This is highest quantity of crude oil loaded on a vessel during the current financial year 15-16.

## Inter Terminal transfer of Tractor-Trailers

The Inter Terminal transfer of Tractor Trailers (ITT), which was a long pending demand of the trade, was started in the month of Feb. Earlier a Tractor Trailer (TT) could not make a sideways movement to the other Terminal, after this initiative, a TT carrying export containers enter GTI/NSICT, drops them there, makes a sideways movement to JNPT, picks up import cargo and moves out of the gate.

This initiative which was started for ease in transaction by the trade with the Terminals by reducing congestion has not only helped in reducing congestion on the approach roads but resulted in each TT saving 7.5 kms of extra run during each trip. This has helped the trade in savings of approx. Rs. 2.86 crores so far, w.e.f from 24th Feb, 2015, when this initiative was started.



# Swachh Bharat Abhiyan *at* JN Port



Under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, JNPort has undertaken various activities in the recent months like:

- To create awareness about Swachh Bharat Abhiyan among the employees, students and residents, various educative banners are displayed in and around the office and township area.
- Upkeep and cleaning of office premises including common area, toilets, stairs, lifts of Administration Building, POC Building, Training Centre, Guest House, Hospital, Schools and CISF campus was undertaken.

Mumbai: Jawaharlal Nehru Port, the No. 1 Container Port of India bagged the prestigious MALA award for "Container handling Port of the Year" at the Maritime and Logistics Awards 2015 for its impressive performance in container handling.
