JN Port operated Container Terminal has permitted M/s. Hyundai Merchant Marine India Pvt. Ltd., to handle more cargo within the existing window hours subsequent to up-sizing vessels under their China India Express (CIX) Service effective from the call scheduled on 30 November 2015. Now the service operator can handle 4700 moves as against earlier 4200 moves on an average per voyage without change in other window parameters.

SHIPPING LINES IMPLEMENT E-DO

As part of transparency and ease of doing business initiative, 30 Shipping Lines out of 31 associated with JN Port have done away with Manual handing over of Delivery Orders by CHAs to CFSs by implementing e-delivery of orders. With this, a consignee/CHA need not stand in queue at the shipping agencies counter for submission of documents / payment and verification which normally takes more time.

After the implementation of e-DO procedure upon receipt of original documents i.e. Bill of Lading (BL), consignee/CHA approaches Shipping Agency and submits the same. Upon verification of documents, shipping agency sends Invoice to consignee/CHA through email. The Consignee/CHA then makes payment through RTGS. Upon receipt of payment, shipping agency generates e-DO in a pdf format and sends the same to CFS/Consignee/CHA through email. The consignee/CHA can approach the shipping agency even before filing IGM / arrival of vessel if they receive original documents and obtain e-DO prior to landing of containers.

JNPCT to add new equipment as volume grows



MUMBAI Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust unveiled a new equipment upgrade plan in an attempt to further improve service levels at India's biggest Container Gateway. The port issued a global tender for the acquisition of 15 rubber-tyre gantry cranes that will double the

number of RTGs deployed at the State-owned Jawaharlal Nehru Port Container Terminal and also increase its cargo-handling capacity by 6.5 million tonnes per year. The Rs. 200 crore (\$30 million) contract is expected to be awarded early next year, according to port officials.

Despite slowing global trade, JNPCT has seen significant

throughput gains this year. Statistics show that the port terminal's volume was up by about 35 percent year-over-year during November.

Throughput at JNPCT from April to November, the first eight fiscal months, expanded by 5.5 percent compared to the same period in 2014, according to the newest data.

JN Port calls for SEZ proposals

Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust has issued a tender calling for proposals for new domestic and international special economic zone, as India's largest container handler looks for new avenues to develop infrastructure facilities at the SEZ site and the SEZ is critical to its plans to expand capacity. The project aims to ensure end-to-end port related facilities for export-import, warehousing, value-added services like sorting, assembling, packaging and distribution. The port-based, multi-modal facility will be developed in a 100-acre area near the port.

JNPCT-APEC Port Training Centre aims attaining self-sustainability within 3 years

MUMBAI In a path-breaking initiative, the Honble Shri Nitin Gadkari, Union Minister for Shipping during his visit to ANTWERP in November, 2014 invited the Antwerp Port Authority and its Training Centre, APEEC Antwerp-Flanders Training Centre, to set up a similar international class Port Training Centre in India.

This has been formalised with an MOU having been signed between Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust and APEEC Antwerp-Flanders Training Centre on 11th February, 2015 to establish the JNPCT/APEC Port Training Centre in JN Port area at Navi Mumbai. The APEEC Antwerp-Flanders Training Centre is affiliated to the Antwerp Port Authority, a municipally owned agency. The Centre has since successfully organised two training programs in

February and August, 2015 with 32 participants from Major Port Trusts, Private Ports and Terminal Operators. The programs were conducted by experts from Antwerp and included classroom sessions and interactive workshops and exercises providing theoretical knowledge and building practical skills. The participants, in their feedback, have immensely valued the training content and felt better equipped to handle the new challenges and meet customer requirements. The Centre is envisaged to be managed by a non-profit company jointly owned by JNPCT with equal equity participation and aims at attaining self-sustainability within 3 years. The infrastructure for Centre meeting international standards is being developed at JN Port.

During the coming year 2016, at least 6 training programs have been planned

with different themes - "Strategy, Policy and Business Development in February; "Managing Change and Effective Leadership" in April; "Ports and Terminals in Supply Chain Logistics" in June; "Port Administration and Management" in August; "Port and Terminal Operations: Achieving Operational Excellence" in October and "Engineering Ports to Exceed Customer Expectations" in November. Registrations are open to participants from Major Port Trusts, Private Ports and Terminals in India and from Ports/Terminals abroad. Apart from the key aspects of port operations, the underlying focus is also to enhance and develop skills for business development, Strategies and Marketing and also instilling behavioural changes to lead effectively in the fast-changing business environment.

JNPCT excels in gross berth productivity, throughput



In November 2015, the Jawaharlal Nehru Port monthly average gross berth productivity of 73 TEU per berth per hour. The previous best was 62 moves per hour. Also, the cargo throughput of JNPCT increased 5.5 per cent for April-December 2015 in comparison to the same period in 2014.
