### New Reefer Yard ready for operations

A newly constructed Reefer Yard was inaugurated by Shri. Anil Diggikar, Chairman, JNPT, on 21st January 2016. The reefer yard has a provision of additional 264 live reefer points with back-up facilities. With the opening of this new reefer yard, JNPT, now, will have at its disposal 576 number of live reefer points as against earlier 216 number of live reefer points with back-up. This will facilitate smooth flow of laden EXIM containerized cargo through JNPT.

## New Year. New Beginning. More Momentum

The beginning of the New Year saw a 28% increase in Port owned Container Terminal (JNPCT) performance, compared to last January 2015. It handled 1, 27,246 TEUs leading to an increase of 9.76% YoY performance.

The port handled 3, 77,581 TEUs, a 0.4% increase of YoY performance. The total liquid cargo handled by JNPT-Liquid Cargo Jetty increased by 7.7% for Apr-Jan, 2015-16 compared to Apr-Jan, 2014-15. The Gross crane productivity of JNPCT for Jan-16 was 19.47 moves/hour, which is second best in this financial year.

A brief presentation on the important performance parameters was done by Shri A. K. Bose, Chief Manager (T). The meet highlighted various issues such as the swift handling of the disruption of NSICT operations, the tactful handling of the dwell time of ICD containers during the Inter Terminal Rail Handling Operation (ITRHO), implementation of Automation of Gates by all Terminals, the weighing of containers as per the Safety of Life at Sea Convention (SOLAS) amendment, which comes into effect from 1st July 2016 and other related issues were discussed.
