The center will provide and impart proper technical training in different disciplines to PAPs and people in nearby areas in order to create suitable skilled labor force to cater to the diverse requirements of maritime logistics and other allied industries.

Shri Sanjay Sethi, IAS, Chairman, JNPT shared his experience during the event and importance of skill development, the PMKK scheme, and the opportunities available for the youth. He further added, "With these new sessions, we aim to impart relevant skills to the students for all the port-related activities. There is a huge scope for these programs as there are various projects like airport and road construction projects which require relevant skilled resources from the logistics sector."

Currently JNPT operates five container terminals: the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Container Terminal (JNPCT), the Nhava Sheva International Container Terminal (NSICT), the Gateway Terminals India Pvt. Ltd. (GTIPL), Nhava Sheva International Gateway Terminal (NSIGT) and the newly commissioned Bharat Mumbai Container Terminals Private Limited (BMCTPL). The Port also has a Shallow Water Berth for general cargo and another Liquid Cargo Terminal which is managed by BPCL-IOCL consortium.
