Sub: Terminal Handling Charges of DPD containers at JNPCT.

Attention of all importers, Shipping Lines/Agents and all other stakeholders is invited to PN11/2020 issued by Jawahar Customs dated 17.01.2020 regarding Terminal Handling Charges of DPD containers.

Levy of DPD Charges at JNPCT will be discontinued from 24th February, 2020.

On the basis, Port intends to collect all Terminal Handling Charges as per Scale of Rates in addition to charges mentioned vide Trade Notice JNP/CM (T)/DPD/2018/2826 dated 6th December, 2018 (except DPD Charges) from willing AEO importers registered under DPD for delivery of Import DPD containers from JNPCT as indicated below.

460 2012/2020 Port will also collect Dwell Time charges, if any, for DPD containers from willing importers directly as per TAMP approved Tariff.

All willing Importers with AEO certificate who have not registered yet need to be registered and open a PD account with JNPT. All **registered willing AEO importers** need to maintain Minimum Balance depending upon the basis of average fortnightly handling of containers by Importers as per details given below:

Slab	Volume Handled (Fortnightly)	Minimum Balance (in Rs.)
Slab I	1-10 TEU's	48,000.00
Slab II	11-25 TEU's	1,20,000.00
Slab III	26-50 TEU's	2,40,000.00
Slab IV	51-100 TEU's	4,80,000.00
Slab V	More than 100 TEU's	6,00,000.00

All registered DPD importers other than Willing importers need to maintain minimum balance as per Trade Notice No. JNP/FIN/R-CT/2017 dated 12th September, 2017. The minimum balance will be kept as security deposit and no interest will be paid on this amount. It will not be adjusted against PD account and will be refunded at the time of closure along with balance in PD account if any.

All payments are to be made in advance through PCS1x only. PCS1x registration of many importers is already completed by PCS1x team and username and password along with user guide is available on JNPT's website. All newly registered willing Importers need to register in PCS1x under link stake holder registration on website: www.indianpcs.gov.in. For system/PCS1x related issue with JNPT, you may contact on 6781 5180 or ctcctech@inpot.com and pcs@inport.gov.in.

In case PD account becomes negative (Debit), the account will be deactivated automatically and importer will not be able to take for DPD delivery. To avoid deactivation of accounts, Importers shall ensure that sufficient balance in PD account is always maintained and all necessary payments towards DPD charges or any other charges are to be made 3 days in advance before arrival of such containers, through PCS1x only. The account will automatically activated after payment.

Accordingly, all existing DPD Importers and willing DPD Importers with AEO certificate are requested to deposit Minimum Balance Amount latest by 25th February, 2020 (if not deposited earlier) and abide by above procedure to ensure smooth delivery of DPD containers from Terminal.

List of willing importers having valid AEO Status, FAQ and minimum balances to be maintained by willing importers will be displayed on JNPT web site www.jnport.gov.in under 'Direct Port Delivery'.

This Trade Notice will come into force for all vessel arriving on or after 24th February, 2020.
